Dear Mr. Douglass:

Reference is made to your letter of 10 December, 1982, subject as above.

A review of recent reports concerning the Rocky Creek WWTP confirms your comment related to the design flow of this plant. I see no problems in allowing the estimated 52,000 gpd flow of Phase I of the Rolling Green Village Project to be treated at the Rocky Creek Plant. A cursory review of this project's planning construction schedule and a similar planning schedule for the construction of the Rocky Creek pump station / Wade Hampton line indicates that this project's discharge would be treated at the Rocky Creek facility for only a short period before being transferred to the Wade Hampton facility. This situation reinforces this agency concurrence in your proceeding with the Rolling Green Village project. DHEC will permit the additional flow requested upon review and approval of adequate plans and specifications.

Your continued cooperation with this office in this situation is appreciated. Please keep us advised in a timely manner of future possible discharge requirements to this facility. I will make an effort to respond in a similar manner so as to not disrupt your planning cycles.
