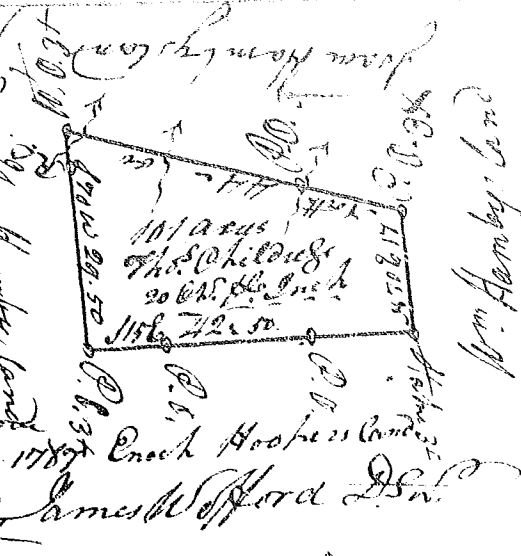


South Carolina 9th District

Situate between the 28<sup>th</sup> & Middle forks of Sugar River, on both sides of James Creeks and hath such form marks, bothings and Boundings as the above plat Represents. Surveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> June 1787

South Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of Locations in 9th District N<sup>o</sup> 3412, dated the 9<sup>th</sup> July 1787 I have admeasured and laid out unto James Betterton a tract of four hundred & twelve acres of land, in spartanburg County, on both sides of Dutchmans Creek waters of Sugar river, bounded by a line running S.W. x by lands surveyed for David Priddy, & by a line running N.E. by lands surveyed for Absalom Lancaster, all other sides Vacant, and hath such form and Marks as the above Plat Represents, Surveyed 11<sup>th</sup> July 1787
