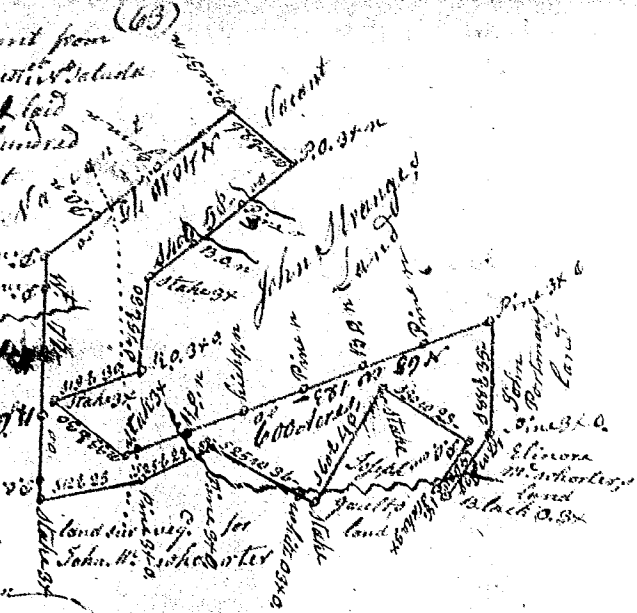
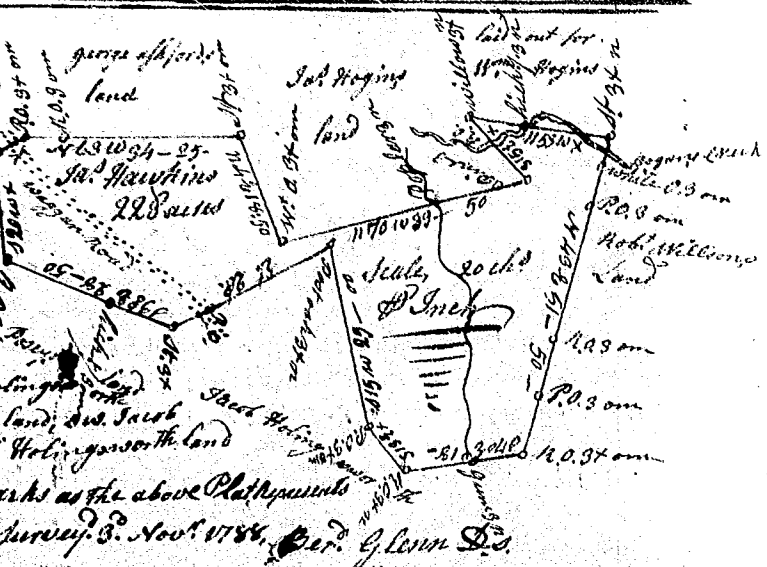


South Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from (63)
