

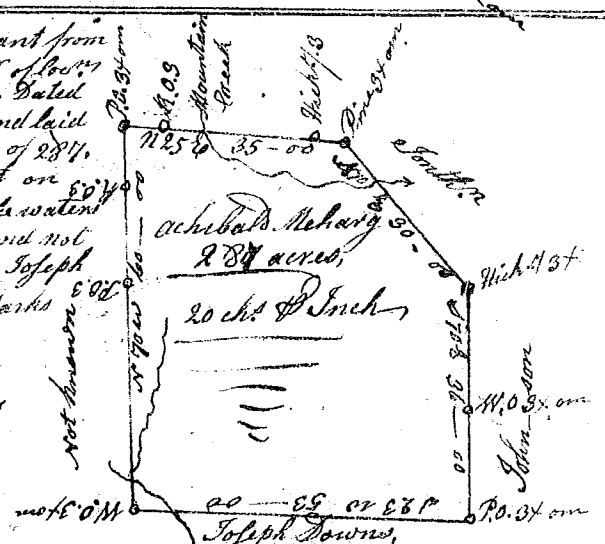

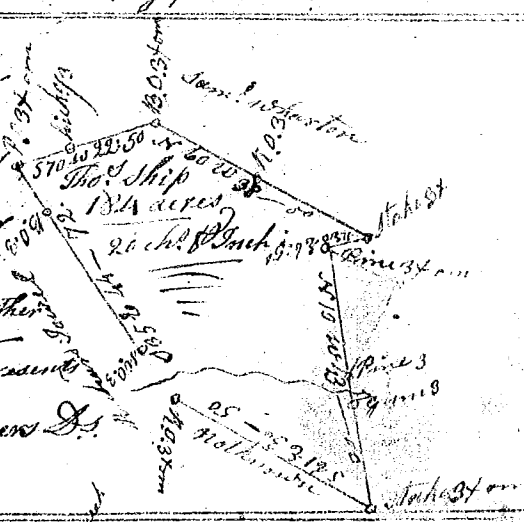

 out unto Archibald Melarg, a tract of 287 1/2  
 acres of land situated in said district on  
 a branch called Mountain-Creek the waters  
 of Keburns Creek, bounding S<sup>c</sup> on land not  
 known, N<sup>e</sup> on South Johnson & East on Joseph  
 Downs, and hath such shape and Marks  
 as the above Plat represents.
