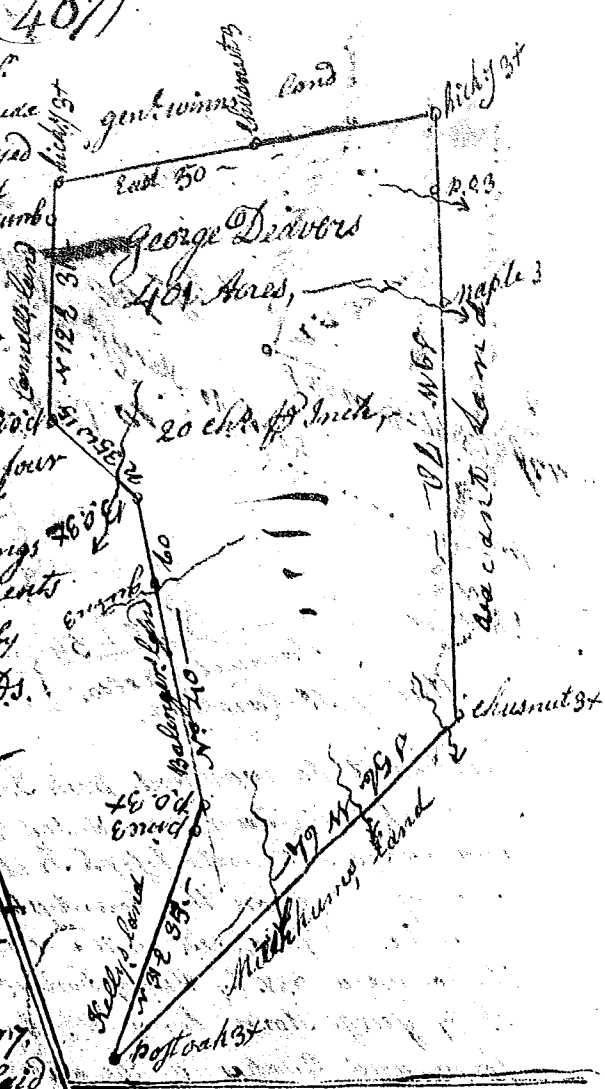


South Carolina Pursuant to (407)
