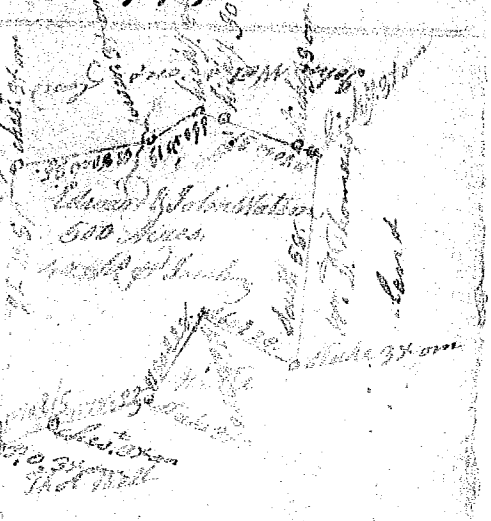


State of South Carolina, Pursuant to agreement from John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of locations on side Saluda river, dated 29 August 1799
 I have measured and laid out unto Joseph Mc Cook a tract of four hundred & thirty seven acres of land, on both sides of Thompson's beaver dam creek, of Middle Sugar river, in Greenville County, bounding by lines S 82° E 200' by land laid out for Joseph Mc Cook & Edward Watson, Sr. by land surveyed for Maj. Popham, N 75° W 100' by Joseph Mc Cook, N 75° W 100' by James Gray & John Smith & S by land surveyed for James Clarke & Nathl. Suck slope form & marks as the above Plat represents.

Suck, S 82° E 200' by John Thomas land and both such form & marks as the above plat represents.
