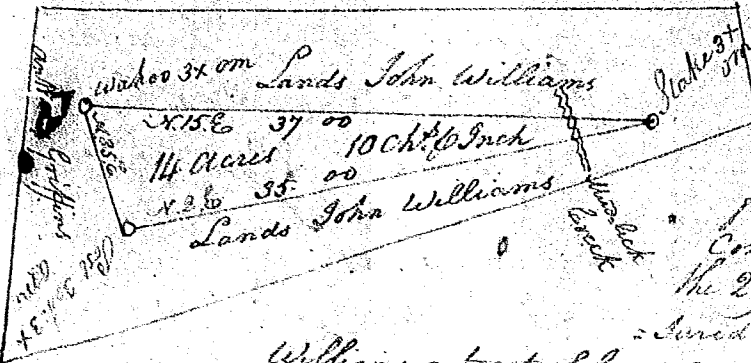

 on the waters of ~~Cane Creek~~ bounded by a line Saluda called the dry
 fork of Cane Creek bounded by a line running N 60 E 160.50 on Benjamin
 Moreland by a line running S 37 W 37 chains on William Ben Moreland
 and by a line running N 85 W 42 chains on William Caldwell Esq. Land
 and by a line running S 26 E 30 chains N 85 W 16 chains S 5 E 35 chains
 and S 70 E 41 chains on Thomas Burns land and hath
 such shape from 8 marks as the above plat Represents
