N<sup>o</sup> Saluda River Dated the 27<sup>th</sup> of  
Dec<sup>r</sup> 1791. I have admeasured and laid  
out unto Lewis Durwall a Tract of  
Nine hundred & three acres situate  
in said district on the Branches of  
Warriors Creek and the Beaver Dam

and Bounding S<sup>o</sup> on land laid out for M<sup>r</sup> Lindess W<sup>o</sup> Thomas Simson  
N<sup>o</sup> on Martin Williams Eastwardly on M<sup>r</sup> Bell, John Baughan &  
William Turner & all other Boundaries on Land Not Known hath  
such shape form & marks as the above plat Represents.

Surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> day of January 1792.

S<sup>o</sup> Carolina & pursuant to a war  
Newbury C<sup>o</sup> grant from John Thomas  
Com<sup>r</sup> of Locations North Saluda dated the 2<sup>d</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1792. I have  
admeasured and laid out unto Jacob King a tract of fifty three acres of  
land on the waters of Indian Creek, bounded by a line running W<sup>o</sup> by  
lands surveyed for Samuel Proctor S<sup>o</sup> by land surveyed for Jacob  
King and all other sides by land surveyed for John Lindsay  
and hath such shape and marks as the above plat Represents
