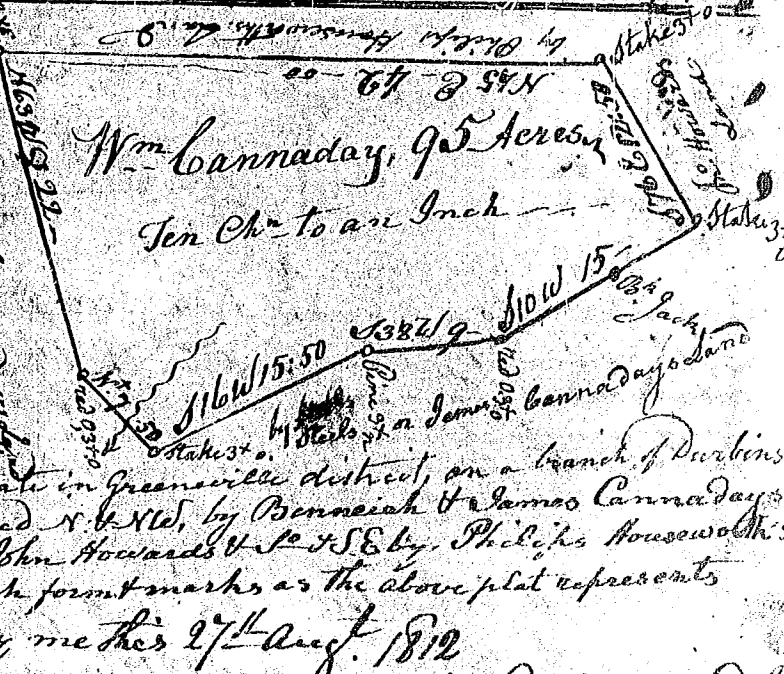

E. westerly by land survey for Thomas Wood & Ephraim Ellis. S. E. by land survey for Thomas Jew — and on all other sides by vacant land, and hath such form & marks as the above plat represents. Survey'd the 16th July 1812. Recorded the 31st July 1812.

Pursuant to a warrant from Wm D. Thomas, Com. Sur. in Greenville district dated the 24th Aug. 1812, I have admeasured & laid out unto William Cannaday a tract of Ninety five acres of land, Situate in Greenville district, on a branch of Durbin's Creek. Bounded N. & N. W. by Benniech & James Cannaday's land, W. by John Howards & S. & S. E. by Philip's Howsoworth's land, & hath such form & marks as the above plat represents. Certified by me this 27th Aug. 1812.
