I have admeasured and laid out unto Joseph Edwards for a tract of Land containing, Four hundred and ten acres situated in the said District on the north and middle prongs of forks of brushy creek waters of Catawba River bounded by a line bounded by a line running N. E. N. W. N. E. and N. W. by land surveyed for John D. Shookley and John Howell N. W. and S. E. by land surveyed for Vardry McVee, and William Turpin N. E. and S. E. and S. W. S. E. by land surveyed for Abraham Green, and hath such form and marks as the above plot represents.
