Pursuant to a Warrant from William Blasingame, Com. Ex. Officio Commissioner of Locations in the District of Greenville, dated the fifth day of February, 1844, I have admeasured and laid out unto George W. King and James T. Blalock a Tract of Land containing Five Acres, situate in the said District, near Maple Swamp Creek, Branch Waters of South Tyger River, and on the North West side of a Road running from Morgan's Bridge on Oncon River, to Mustell's Mill on South Tyger River bounded by a line—Running N. E. by Land surveyed for McClimons Heirs N. E. and S. E. by Land surveyed for Samuel Walker and James T. Blalock S. W. by Land surveyed for Elias W. Newton's and South such form and marks as the above plat represents.
