All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
situated, lying and being in the City and
County of Greenville, State of South Carolina,
and in Ward No. 2 of said City, being a portion
of the Rowley Place and having the following
metes and bounds, to-wit: Commencing at
an iron stake, northeast corner of Lavinia
Avenue and a 10-foot alley, and running
thence in an easterly direction along said
alley, 145 feet to a stake; thence in a
northerly direction to a stake on a 1-foot
alley; thence along said alley 43 feet to an
iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 24 and 25;
thence in a southeasterly direction along
