G.V. Farrell, deceased, Two Thousand (\$2000.00) Dollars, to be paid, before one year from date of September 1st, 1929

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be computed and paid on January 1, 1929 and on January 1st, thereafter
