Bernice Endel: All that Piece, Parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about five miles above Travelers Rest, S. C. on the Buncombe Road, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake in the road leading to Greer; and running thence N. 18 3/4 E. 13.00 to a stone 0m; thence N. 30 1/2 E. 6.00 to a stake on the branch; thence N. 26 1/2 E. 5.20 to a stone 0m; thence N. 25 1/2 E. 1.57 to an iron Pin in the road; thence N. 55 W. 7.67 to a Pin x 30m; thence N. 72 1/2 W. 5.40 to a stake 0m; thence S. 40 1/3 W. 30.38 to iron Pin in Old Buncombe Road; thence with Old Road bed S. 33 E. 5.76 to a stake in the road leading to Greer; thence S. 74 1/2 E. 6.50 to angle; thence S. 86 E. 6.75 to an angle; thence N. 84 1/2 E. 4.00 to the beginning corner; and containing fifty (50) acres, more or less.
