.....per cent. per annum, payable weekly,  
the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

in Greenville Township, near Monaghan Mill about two miles west of the Greenville Capt House and being a part of a ~~sub. division~~ known as City View and having the following meter and bounds: Beginning at a stake corner of Summit Street and Hunt Street and running thence with Hunt Street 100 feet to a stake adjoining corner of lots Nos. 117, 118; thence with joining lines of said lots in an easterly direction 170 feet to a stake joining corner of lots Nos. 117, 118, 117A, 118A; thence in a southerly direction 150 feet to a stake on Summit Street; thence with Summit Street 150 feet to beginning corner, known as lots Nos. 115, 116 and 117, as shown by plat of City View as recorded in Plat Book A, page 460, R.M.C. Office for said county, being the same conveyed to me by A. C. Robinson by deed dated January 5, 1923, recorded in Book 78, page 453.
