Dollars, money loaned this day with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Near the White Horse Road, being a portion of lot no 9 as shown on plat of St. A. Workman, made by C. M. Furdan, Engineer, March 24, 1924, said being described as follows:
Beginning at an iron pin at the southwest corner of Link Street and Gordon Avenue, and running thence with Gordon Avenue S. 80-08 24. 26 feet to iron pin, joint corner lots 9 and 8; thence with line of lot no 8 S. 10-40 24. 165 feet; thence in a straight line to point on Link Street 190 feet from the corner of Link Street and Gordon Avenue; thence with Link Street 190 feet to the beginning corner being the same conveyed to Greenville Trading Company by John A. Russell by deed dated October 18, 1928, recorded in Book 146, page 345.

~~Also that~~ other lot of land in County and State aforesaid, being known and designated as lot no 11 of Plat of recorded in R. M. Co. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, page 288 and described as follows, # 6549
Beginning at a pin on the north side of Ottaway Street, joint corner of lots 1 and 10, and running thence along rear line of lots nos 1, 2, 10 N. 10-49 E. 162 feet; thence along rear line of lot no 7 S. 86-30 E. 50 feet to pin at corner of lots 8, 10 and 11; thence S. 10-49 24. 162 feet to Ottaway Street; thence N. 86-30 24. 50 feet to the beginning being the same conveyed to Greenville Trading Company by Annie S. Moore, by deed dated December 29, 1928, recorded in Book 143, page 49.
