Parcel - 75: all the timber and trees of every kind and description now and hereafter within 30 years from March 17, 1921, situate, lying and being upon the following described four tracts or parcels of land:

(a) a certain tract of land commonly known as "Robinson Tract" containing 78.6 acres, more or less;

(b) a certain tract of land commonly known as the "McCombs Tract", containing 109.5 acres, more or less;

(c) a certain tract of land commonly known as the "Poole Tract", containing 235 acres, more or less;

(d) $\frac{1}{2}$ interest in a certain tract of land commonly known as the "Dalton" or "Kare" tract, containing 400 acres, more or less.

All the above tracts, (a), (b), (c), and (d), situate, lying and being on waters of South and Middle Saluda Rivers, Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, timber having been conveyed to the Mortgagee by J. Parcel - 76: all the timber and trees of every kind and description both standing and fallen, now or hereafter, within 12 years from February 18, 1920, upon that certain boundary of land known as the "Harriet D. Wilkins Tract" situate, lying and being in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina bounded on the North by lands now or formerly of J. Norwood Cleveland, et al.; on the West and South by lands of the Mortgagee et al.; on the South and East by Middle Saluda River. These lands are designated as Tract one, Two, and Three on a plat thereof prepared by A. S. Hardin, C. E., (756 ac. January 12, 1920.) The timber and trees having been conveyed unto the Mortgagee by Harriet D. Wilkins under deed bearing date February 18, 1920.
