

All my undivided one half interest in and to these certain lots of land in State and County aforesaid, situated lying and being on Endel and Gower Streets near the City of Greenville, being designated as lots nos. one, two, three, eight, ten, and eleven on plat recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book J, Page 230, and having according to said Plat the following meters and bounds:

Beginning at Southwest Corner of eight foot alley on north side of Endel Street and running thence along said street S. 58-40 W. 112.2 feet thence N. 16-27 W. 193.6 feet to right of way of Southern Railway Company; thence along said right of way N. 62-33 E. 100 feet to Gower Street; thence along Gower Street S. 58-20 E. 34 feet to corner of lot no. 9; thence along line of that lot S. 58-40 W. 84.9 feet to a point in line of lot no. 11; thence along line of that lot S. 31-27 E. 30 feet in line of lot no. 8; thence along line of that lot N. 58-40 E. to intersection of lot no. 7; thence along line of that lot in Southeastern direction to corner of lot no. 4 at head of and being Northeast corner of eight foot alley; thence S. 58-40 W. crossing said alley 8 feet to Northeast corner of lot no. 3; thence along line of said alley and lot no. 3, 90 feet to the beginning corner.

All right, title and interest in and to the alley above referred to is hereby conveyed to mortgage, her heirs and assigns, subject to the conditions of this mortgage.
