

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, A. B. Willson

of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, A. B. Willson, the said, in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 14th day of May 1929

indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Thirty-eight hundred and no/100 (\$3800.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly from the 14th day of May A. D. 1929

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

I, the said A. B. Willson shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville, in the aforesaid monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of June 1929

and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Sixty and 17/100 (\$60.17) Dollars,

being the regular monthly installment payable on the Thirty-eight Shares of Stock and Twenty-two and 17/100 (\$22.17) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of

Fifty-five and 13/100 (\$55.13) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Twenty and 17/100 (\$20.17) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

for the next twenty months the sum of Fifty-one and 30/100 (\$51.30) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and

(Thirty and 13/100 (\$30.13) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and

Forty-six and 87/100 (\$46.87) Dollars, being the monthly installment on said shares of stock and

Eight and 87/100 (\$8.87) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of

Forty-two and 43/100 (\$42.43) Dollars, being the monthly installment on said shares of stock and

Four and 43/100 (\$4.43) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 38 shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made by me, the said

A. B. Willson and shall pay or cause to be paid all fees which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me, the said, in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition hereunder written, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said A. B. Willson, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me

the said A. B. Willson, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Lying on the Western side of Watts Avenue, and known and designated as lot No. 25 according to a plat of the Property of Parrish, Gower and Martin, made by J. Walton & George Engineers, March 1928, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "G" at Page 197 and having, according to the said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit: - Beginning at an iron pin on the Northern side of Watts Avenue, which iron pin is 291.3 feet from the North Western intersection of Watts and Mc Daniels Avenues, joint corner of lots nos. 25 and 26 and running thence along the joint line of said lots N. 0-48 E. 175 feet to an iron pin in the line of the play ground, near joint corner of lots nos. 25 and 26; thence along the Southern line of said play ground N. 88-58 W. 52 feet to an iron pin in the line of a four foot path; thence along the Eastern side of said four foot path S. 0-48 W. 175 feet to an iron pin, the Northeastern intersection of the four foot path and Watts Avenue; thence along the Northern side of Watts Avenue S. 88-58 E. 52 feet to the point of beginning being the same land conveyed to A. B. Willson by J. C. B. Martin, W. D. Parrish and J. C. Gower of May 10, 1929, by deed recorded in Vol 138 Page 258 of R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
