or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said The First National Bank of Greer, S.C.

That certain lot of land, with the improvements thereon, in the City of Greer, Chick Springs Township, said County, and State, fronting on Church Street of said City of Greer, and measuring thereon approximately two hundred feet, and on the other two sides by lands of my brother, J. A. Waldrop; and measuring thereon approximately sixty and two hundred feet on the respective lines: This being part of the property deeded to my father, J. M. Waldrop by J. R. Payne, and deeded to J.
