SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *A*, the said *Rosa Ross Cason* in and by *A* certain *promissory note*, in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to *Alisia M. Fulmer* \$40<sup>00</sup>

in the full and just sum of *Eight hundred fifty nine and 70/100 Dollars*, to be paid *and bears* of *31.00 per quarter*, beginning *March 1, 1929*, and to be paid *on the fifteenth* of each *any* every *June, September, December and March* thereafter, *as unpaid balance* being due and payable on *December first, 1938*. *At 6% per annum* per cent. per annum to be computed and paid *less* annual *28 days of April*.

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to best interest at the same rate as principal and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *100\$ of attorney due*

*at least twice the amount due* *plus reasonable expenses* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *Rosa Ross Cason* the said *Alisia M. Fulmer*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Alisia M. Fulmer*

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said *Rosa Ross Cason*

*at 11/100* in hand well and truly paid by the said *Alisia M. Fulmer*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Alisia M. Fulmer*

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in Ward 8<sup>th</sup> of the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the south west intersection of Jones Avenue and a proposed street, dividing the lands of Stella T. Findall and W. B. McFarland, and running thence with Jones Avenue S. 0-35 W. sixty feet to an iron pin; thence N. 85-15 W. 170 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 0-35 E. sixty feet to an iron pin; thence with proposed Street S. 85-15 E. 170 feet to the point of beginning, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me the said Alisia M. Fulmer by J. C. Tower and W. D. Parish by their deed dated September 15, 1922 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 75 at page 1311.
