*I Elizabeth I Dashiell*

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Elizabeth I. Dashiell*  
in and by *a* certain *promissory* note, in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *A. B. Willson* well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of *One thousand twenty-five (\$1,025.00)*  
Dollars, to be paid *\$900.00 on March 1st, 1929 and the balance*  
*of \$125.00 to be paid on a basis of \$5.00 per month,*  
*beginning April 1st, 1929*  
with interest thereon, from *December 18, 1928* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid *semi-annually*

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10% of the amount*  
*due on the note* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I* the said *Elizabeth I. Dashiell*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *A. B. Willson*

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-

lying and being in Ward Six of the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid and being  
known and designated as Lot #24 of the property of Parrish, Gower and Martin as per plat of  
said property recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book G, at page 197.  
Said lot is more particularly described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of  
lots 23 and 24 and running thence N. 0-48 E. 175 feet to an iron pin on the South side of a  
play ground; thence S. 88-58 E. 52 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot 24 and a four foot path  
leading in from Watts Avenue; thence S. 0-48 W. 175 feet to an iron pin on Watts Avenue; thence  
with the north side of Watts Avenue 52 feet to the point of beginning. This is the same lot of  
land conveyed to me, the said Elizabeth I. Dashiell, by Parrish, Gower and Martin by their  
deed dated December 18, 1928.
