SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Lucile S. Boyd,

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred & no/100 Dollars,

to be paid on or before the date when the 37th Series of the Instalment Stock of the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION shall reach maturity, with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly on or before Saturday night of each and every week until paid in full; and if I fail to pay said interest or to comply in all respects with the By-Laws of said Association, for the space of thirty days, then said debt shall become immediately due and payable, together with all interest, fines and expenses, and all amounts advanced by the said Association on the within described property, by way of taxes or insurance, the same to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as part thereof, together with an attorney's fee of ten per cent. if the same be placed in the hand of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as provided in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION all that piece, parcel or lot of land lying in Greenville County, South Carolina,

In Ward One of the City of Greenville and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the South side of Hampton Avenue at Lipscomb's corner; thence with said Avenue 51 feet to corner (formerly Waddell); thence with line formerly Waddell's 150 feet to a 15 foot alley known as Quenton Street; thence with Quenton Street 51 feet to Lipscomb's corner; thence with Lipscomb's line 150 feet to the beginning corner, being the same conveyed to me by C.
