A. Vaughn*

in hand well and truly paid by the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Beginning at a stone 340 m on long branch, thence S. 78 E. 7.00 to a poplar 340 m; thence N. 19 E. 8.00 to a sweet gum 340 m, line of lot no. 1; thence S. 68 W. 38.20 to a pine 340 m; thence S. 27 E. 5.00 to a stone 340 m; thence S. 52 E. 76.80 to a sweet gum 340 m long branch; thence along long branch to the beginning corner, containing 72 acres, more or less. See deed recorded Vol 000, page 137.

Also all that tract of land situate on the south side of Kilders creek, Austin Township, in the State and County aforesaid, beginning at a red oak stump, which is the southeast corner of the 93.9 acres of the Lewis and Jenkins tract and running thence S. 70 W. 10.81 to the center of a new road; thence along the center of said road in a northerly direction 1533 feet to the center of Kilders creek; thence down the meander and center of said creek to a line which runs from the Greenville road S. 16 E.; thence S. 16 E. from the center of said creek 7.65 to the beginning corner, containing 24.8 acres, more or less.
