In the First Ward of the city of Greenville, at the N.E. corner of Laurens and Bunccombe Streets and described as follows: Beginning at a point on the East side of Laurens Street, which point is in a wall and is also the corner of the lot of the estate of J. F. Hodges, deceased, and running thence along the East side of Laurens Street in a Southerly direction 29.7 feet more or less, to the N.E. corner of Laurens and Bunccombe Streets, thence along the E. side of Bunccombe or Coffee Street in a S.E. direction 866.5 feet more or less, to a point in a wall, corner of property of H. H. Burgess, thence with line of property of H. H. Burgess in a northerly direction 78 feet, more or less, to the corner of Burgess property, property of estate of J. F. Hodges, deceased, and C. C.
