hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released,

all that tract or lot of land in the town of Greenville, State of South Carolina, bounded as follows: Beginning at a point on the old Spartanburg Road, 10.3 feet from the intersection of said road and the road leading to the corner of lot heretofore described, running thence westwardly along said road, N. 65-45 W., 8.5 feet to the corner of lot heretofore described, beginning at a point 30 feet west of the corner of lot heretofore described, running thence westwardly along said road, N. 65-45 W., 46-8 E. 37.1 feet to the corner of lot heretofore described, N. 44-22 W. 53.5 feet to an iron pin; thence westwardly along said line 47 E. 772 feet to another iron pin; thence westwardly along said line 46 W. 311 feet to the corner of lot heretofore described, N. 44-22 W. 77.7 feet to an iron pin; thence westwardly along said line in a southwesterly direction 47 E. 338 feet to the beginning, containing 4.33 acres, saving and excepting, however, its 3 acres, each fronting 42 feet on the old Spartanburg Road and having a depth of 150 feet as shown on plat of property of W. C. Mc Bain made by M. L. Fussman, Jr., March 11, 1927. Being part of a tract of land conveyed to me by W. C. Mc Bain by deed dated March 26, 1929 and recorded in R. M. S. Office of said County in Deed Book Vol. 137 at page 58.
