THE DEBT HEREBY SECURED IS PAID IN FULL AND THE LIEN OF THIS INSTRUMENT IS SATISFIED THIS DAY 11/30/30

with interest from the date of this instrument at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid

until paid in full all interest not paid will due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

10% of the amount due plus costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

C. B. Osborne.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, lying on the south side of Vardry Street and being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Vardry Street, corner of Mrs. J. M. Mc Gee's lot and running thence along said Vardry Street N. 70-40 E. 70 feet, thence along line of R. L. Mc Gee's lot S. 32 E. 16 2/3 feet, 6 inches to a stake; thence along Grant's line S. 52 E. 68 feet 8 inches to the said Mrs. J. M. Mc Gee's line; thence along said Mrs. J. M. Mc Gee's line N. 32 E. 18 5/8 feet, 3 1/2 inches to the beginning corner, according to a survey made July 12, 1909. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by C. B. Osborne, by deed dated October 5, 1929.

It is understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto that the lien of the within mortgage is to be junior and inferior to the lien of the following mortgages: First, a mortgage in the original sum of \$5000.00 executed by C. B. Osborne to the Atlantic Life Insurance December 17, 1925, recorded in Mortgage Book 170 at page 22; Second, a mortgage in the original sum of \$1500.00 executed by C. B. Osborne to the Industrial Bank of Richmond December 17, 1925, recorded in Mortgage Book 170 at page 24.
