SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *(X)*, the said *A. J. Farnsworth*,  
 in and by *22d of* certain *1887*,  
 even date with these presents, *lent* to *the said A. J. Farnsworth*,  
 well and truly indebted to *the said A. J. Farnsworth*,

in the full and just sum of *One thousand Dollars*  
 Dollars, to be paid *one year after date*.

with interest thereon, from *the day of* *1887*, at the rate of *eight* ~~per~~ cent. per annum to be  
 computed and paid *quarterly*.

and paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal  
 or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
 sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten percent of the*  
*amount due*.

Besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney, for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
 thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note....., reference being  
 thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *(X)*, the said *A. J. Farnsworth*,  
 in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *A. J. Farnsworth*,

according to the terms of the said note..... and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *the said A. J. Farnsworth*, the said.....

*A. J. Farnsworth*  
 in hand well and truly paid by the said *A. J. Farnsworth*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bar-  
 gain, sell and release unto the said *A. J. Farnsworth*, his heirs and assigns

all that piece of land lying,  
 situate and bounded in the State of South Carolina aforesaid, and in the Township of the  
 following metes and bounds, to wit;

beginning at a point in the center of the Bear-  
 road, R.R. and running thence N. 15 E. 100 feet to  
 a point in the center of said road; thence S. 75 E.  
 110 feet to a corner post; thence S. 15 W. 100 feet to  
 another post; thence W. 75 N. 110 feet to the begin-  
 ning corner, in the center of the Bear-road.

This piece of land contains 15,000 square feet,  
 so far as the said lines, the corner posts and  
 less, and is the same tract of land conveyed to W. G.  
 Stroud by Miss. Marissa J. Strand, by deed dated October 3, 1887, and  
 recorded in Vol. 126 of Deeds for Greenville County, page 264, said  
 land adjoining lands of Mrs. M. J. Stroud and Wake Hawkins. Also:  
 All that tract of land in the Township, County and State aforesaid, or  
 about 15 miles back of the Greenville County Court House, on the Burnside  
 road, or the Hendersonville highway, bounded by lands of Wake Hawkins,  
 D. C. Roswell and George Taylor, and the said highway, containing 5 acres, or  
 less, being the land wherein said Marissa J. Stroud formerly resided, and  
 all the land devised to said Marissa J. Stroud by her husband, Sanford L.  
 Stroud, under his will on file in the Office of the Probate Court for  
 Greenville County, recorded in Apartment 159, File 20, and consisting of  
 all the lands owned by Sanford L. Stroud at the time of his death.  
 A full description of said land or a part of said land, reference  
 is hereby made, to the deed from Adella J. Taylor and others  
 to the said Sanford L. Stroud dated June 14, 1887, and recorded  
 in Deed Book T. I., page 172, K. M. & Office for said Greenville  
 County.
