or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may

*well known half-mile east of Greenville County, South Carolina, a part of a*  
*being the northern part of Lot No. 6, of Block "F",*  
*according to plat of Melrose Land Company, record-*

*ville County, and being the same lot which was*
