SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we, the said J. M. Burdett and Eileen M. Burdett, in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to,

B. W. Burdett, in the full and just sum of Thirty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars, to be paid.

with interest thereon, from January 1st, 1887, at the rate of 5 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid annually, until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, or note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these Presents do grant, bar-

gain, sell and release unto the said B. W. Burdett.

All that certain tract of land situate in Greenville County, South Carolina, consisting of two parcels, containing in the aggregate one hundred and Ninety Nine (199) acres, more or less, and more particularly described as follows:

(1) That certain parcel of land containing 98 acres, more or less, known as Tract #7 of the Ware lands, and being the same conveyed to the late A. W. McDavid by S. J. Whit, master, by deed dated November 1, 1886, and recorded in Book 55, Page 252 at R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and therein described by metes and bounds.

(2) That certain parcel of land containing 101 acres, more or less, known as tract #8 of the Ware lands, being the same conveyed to the late A. W. McDavid by M. L. Freeman by deed dated December 23, 1886, and recorded in Book 55, page 432, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and therein described by metes and bounds.

Excepting however, the parcel of about 5 acres conveyed by the late A. W. McDavid to J. P. Jordan by deed recorded in Book 17, page 522. Also our five-eights (5/8) interest in and to 104 acres, more or less, in Oaklawn Township, County and State aforesaid, known as Ferry Island place and bounded by lands of B. S. Lewis, Fizzie Davis, J. D. Chapman, J. D. Chastain, and Mrs. Beskie Mahaffey.

Any inheritance that we may receive from our respective parents estate shall be applied on this mortgage.
