Oregon Lawton to the Union Trust Company of Maryland and The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Trustees, on the 1st. day of August, 1928 and filed for record in the office of the R. M. C., South Carolina, on the 11th. day of September, 1928, in Book 183, page 157; the property thereby conveyed being described as follows:

Certain real estates in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, particularly described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being the Southern portion of Lot No. 149 as shown on Map No. 3 of Overbrook Land Company, recorded in Plat Book P at page 218, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having, according to a survey made July, 1928, by Dalton & Neres, Engineers, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the East side of Jedwood Drive, which point is 200 feet North of the intersection of Jedwood Drive with Woodville Ave., and running thence with the East side of said Jedwood Drive, N. 6-28 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 83-32 E. 143 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 6-28 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence S 83-32 W. 143 feet to a point on the East side of Jedwood Drive, the point of beginning.

The Register of Deeds for Greenville County is hereby authorized and directed to satisfy Deed of Trust of record by endorsing such satisfaction upon the record of said Deed of Trust in Book No. 183, at Page 157 of Mortgages in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Greenville County, South Carolina.
