For Value Received, and without recourse on us in any event, we, the Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank of Raleigh, hereby transfer, sell and assign to the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, of Columbia, South Carolina, for itself and for as agent of the Land Bank Commissioner, and its successors and assigns, all our right, title and interest in and to that certain and attached note and mortgage deed from H. P. Beam to us, dated December 24, 1924, in the original sum of \$15,000.00 said mortgage being recorded in book 133 at page 255, in the office of the clerk of court for Greenville County, South Carolina, and covering two tracts of land in Oaklawn Township, said County and State.

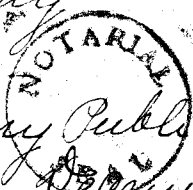
