Release Deed.

Edgar J. Hecht and Leo Haskell, of the City, County and State of New York, Trustees in the deed of trust hereinafter set forth, in consideration of the indebtedness therein secured having been fully paid and satisfied, do hereby release the lien of a certain deed of trust made by Lewis Barker to Edgar J. Hecht and Leo Haskell, Trustees, dated on the 15th day of January, 1933, and filed for record in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances of Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 243 at Page 248, the property thereby conveyed being described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Franklin Road, Sans Souci, near the City of Greenville and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Eastern side of Franklin Road 56 feet from the north east corner Young Street and running thence S. 57-25 E. 165 feet and 4 inches to a stake; thence N. 27-30 E. 56 feet and 2 inches to a stake; thence N 57-25 W. 160 feet and 8 inches to the Franklin Road; thence S. 32-35 W. 56 feet along said Franklin Road to the beginning point.

The Register of Deeds for Greenville County is hereby authorized and directed to satisfy the Deed of Trust of Record by endorsing such satisfaction upon the record of said Deed of Trust in Book no. 243 at Page 248 of mortgages in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Greenville County, South Carolina.
