SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said A. J. Floyd,  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

R. G. Stone,

in the full and just sum of Three Hundred and no/100 (\$300.00)  
Dollars, to be paid on the 15th day of October A. D. 1931.

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of  
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
reue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent of whole amount due thereon. besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof  
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as we  
more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said A. J. Floyd,  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell  
and release unto the said R. G. Stone, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in  
Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being lot #1 of  
property of Eliza T. Looper as shown by plat made by R. E. Dalton, December 1924, and  
described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at corner of Looper and Gordon Streets and running thence with Gordon  
Street S. 71-17 W. 51.5 feet to corner of lot #2; thence with line of lot #2, N. 16-08  
W. 149.8 feet to a point in line of lot #39; thence with line of lot #39; N. 71-17 E.  
69.4 feet to Looper Street; thence with Looper Street S. 9-18 E. 151.8 feet to the  
beginning corner, and being one of the lots conveyed to me by Eliza T. Looper by deed
