WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Eula Belle Wright*

Dollars, to be paid *one year after date of said note*

with interest thereon, from *date full* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *semi-annually*

until paid in full of interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
reue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Five per Cent*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as we
more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said *William Goldsmith, Agent*, the following

described Property:

at an *iron pin* on left side of *Brushy Creek Road*,
running thence *S. 26 5/8 W. 475* feet to a *willow tree*;
thence *S. 22 1/2 E. 278* feet to *stake in branch*; thence
S. 17-7/8 W. 256 feet to a *water oak*; thence *S. 1.00*
E. 133 feet to a *poplar*; thence *N. 66 1/4 W. 207* feet to a
stone; thence *S. 57 1/2 W. 151* feet to a *saw wood*
tree; thence *N. 58 1/2 W. 693* feet to a *stake*; thence
N. 24 1/2 E. 2079 feet to a *stake in center of Enore*
