WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of

money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight percent per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to wit:

In the City of Greenville, on the south side of Ware Street, having the following metes and bounds. Beginning at a stake on Ware Street, at corner of lot now or formerly of B. H. Griffin, and running thence with Griffin line in a southerly direction 120 feet, more or less, to stake; thence with line of lot no. 5 (as shown on plat of the Daisy M. Welborn property made by C. M. Furman, Jr., S. 16-20 E. 48.4 feet to stake; thence N. 73-40 E. 120 feet to stake on Ware Street; thence with Ware Street N. 16-20 W. 62 feet to beginning corner, being the same conveyed by Charlie C. Meyer by deed dated April 2, 1931, recorded in book 158, page 252.

This mortgage is executed by the moderator, Secretary and Deacons and Trustees pursuant to a resolution adopted at a meeting of the members of said corporation duly called and regularly held on the 4th day of March 1931. This mortgage is given to pay for the erection of a parsonage on the lot above described.
