Personally appeared before me Marvin Cymes who, being sworn, deposes and states: That he was employed in the office of the National Credit Corporation in the branch office of the corporation in Greenville, S.C. as agent, and that this Corporation held certain notes, mortgages and other securities pledged with it by the Peoples State Bank of South Carolina, about the year 1931 or 1932.

That the securities pledged by the Peoples State Bank in the Greenville Area to said Corporation were handled through the Greenville office.

That about the year 1933 the receivers of the Peoples State Bank of South Carolina paid the balance due by the bank to the National Credit Corporation and said Corporation transferred and assigned to the receivers of the Peoples State Bank of South Carolina all notes, mortgages and other securities which had not been paid to said Corporation or collected by it, and that the receipt of the receiver for such securities was delivered through this office to the said National Credit Corporation.

That it is this understanding that the National Credit Corporation was liquidated and dissolved many years ago and is no longer in existence.
