principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

..... ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being

gain, sell and release unto the said R. D. Dobson

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying
and being in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County, in
the town of Greer, on the South side of Arlington Avenue, for-
merly mentioned as Dixie Street, and having the following metes
and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron on the South side of
the said Arlington Ave. (Ch. A. Rogers' corner) and running thence
with the said Street S. 83 3/4 E. 80 feet to Drummond's corner; thence
with his line S 13 1/2 W 184 feet to a stake; thence N. 74 3/4 W. 80 feet
to a stake in Rogers' line; thence with said line N. 13 1/2 E. 175 feet
to the beginning corner, and being all of the lot conveyed to
Virginia H. Dobson by the City Council of Greer in deed dated
May 2nd, 1919, and recorded in Vol. 25 page 296 Register of Meuse
Conveyance Office, Greenville County, excepting and reserving, however
and it is a part of this conveyance, that an alley 10 feet in
width along the south-west side of said lot be and remain
open unobstructed for the use of the city going to and from lot

Smith's lot that fronts on Church Street); thence S. 83-30 E. 46.8 feet to
an iron pin; thence N. 17-13 E. 225 feet to an iron pin in the edge of Ar-
lington Avenue; thence with Arlington Avenue N. 83-30 W. 61.2 feet to the
