until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of.

Twenty Five Dollars, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collected as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of law (part of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. M. Gaffney, his heirs and assigns,

all that certain parcel or lot of land situate in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid on the north side of Elford Street between North Main and Townes Streets, said lot having a frontage of 82 feet 2 inches on Elford St. and a depth of 95 feet. This being the same property conveyed by Jas. Brine to W. A. Wallace and J. Thomas Arnold by deed dated May 9th, 1912 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in book 19 at page 292 and being the same property conveyed to Ellen I. Arnold by J. Thomas Arnold by deed dated January 2nd, 1918 and recorded in said office in book 43 at page 291. The said J. Thomas Arnold having acquired the undivided one half interest of the said W. A. Wallace by deeds recorded in the said office in Deeds 21 and 39 at pages 465 and 538 respectively. This also being the same property conveyed to J. D. Arnold by Ellen I. Arnold by deed dated January 22nd, 1919 and recorded in said office in vol. 45 at page 154 and being the same property conveyed to me by J. D. Arnold by deed dated December 15th, 1930 and recorded in said office in vol. 153 at page 377. Reference is hereby made to all of said deeds for a more particular description and the descriptions therein are incorporated herein.
