SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *S. D. McAfee*
in and by *My* certain *Promissory* note... in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

W. C. Henson
in the full and just sum of *Six Hundred (600.00) Dollars*
Dollars, to be paid *one year from date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *Annually* until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *W. C. Henson*

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *S. D. McAfee*, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-
gain, sell and release unto the said *W. C. Henson*, his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate
lying and being in *O'Neal Township, County and State*
aforesaid, containing *seventy-eight and two-thirds*
(78-2/3) acres more or less, adjoining lands now or for-
merly belonging to *Isiah Gibson, E. A. Johnson, G. B.*
Wood and others, and being more particularly described as
follows:

Beginning at a poplar and runs thence *S. 11 1/4 W.*
3 rods to a stone; thence *S. 10 1/4 E. 6.06 chs.* to a stone;
thence *S. 6 1/2 E. 19.76 chs.* to a stone; thence *S. 1. 20. 6.18*
chs. to a stake in branch; thence up the meanderings of
said branch about *17 chs.* to a stone; thence *N. 36 E. 1*
23.67 chs. to a stone; thence *N. 60 W. 7.65 chs.* to a
stone; thence in a south west course *18 chs.* to a stone
near head of branch; thence with meanderings of said
