for and in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said,

*Clifton Fowler*  
all that tract or lot of land in *O'Neal* Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake in Rutherford road running thence N. 65 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 8.00 to a stake, thence S. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 2.00 to a stake, thence S. 49 E. 6.50 to a stake on road, thence along said Rutherford road N. 50 E. 4.18 to the beginning corner containing Two (2) acres, more or less bounded by lands of J. H. Payne, J. B. Brookshire and Earnest Thrash.

Also, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the state and county aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning on small Hickory on East side of road at Tom Andersons corner and runs thence N. 77 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 6.25 chs. to a stake in James Dills line, thence with Dills line S. 56 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 9.49 to a stone near branch, thence S. 47 $\frac{3}{4}$  E. 7.62 to a stone at corner Negro Church lot, thence N. 60 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 6.57 chs. to another stone corner Negro Church lot, thence N. 35 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 6.28 chs. to the beginning corner and contains seven and ninety eight one hundred (7.98) acres, more or less.

Also, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the state and county aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning on a rock on the North side of the Rutherford road Negro Church corner, and runs thence N. 59.30 E. 2.82 chs. to a stake in the road, thence N. 48.40 W. 6.54 to a stake, thence S. 25.15 W. 2.82 chs. to a stone at corner of Negro Church lot, thence S. 48.40 E. 4.86 chs. to the beginning containing one and fifty sevenths (1.57) acres, more or less.
