SEND GREETING:

Whereas, *J. B. Raser* the said.in and by *W. J. Raser* certain *pluris* *provisor*

note in writing, of even date with

these presents, *at the* well and truly indebted to *J. B. Raser Jr.*in the full and just sum of *Eleven Hundred, Eighty Two and 15/100 (\$1182.50) Dollars*  
to be paid *one year after date* *15-3-85*with interest thereon from *date* *THE DEBT BECOMES DUE AND PAYABLE AT THE*at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *W. J. Raser Jr.*  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past  
due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose  
this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee *ten percent upon*  
besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the  
hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured  
under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being *reunto* how more fully appear.NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That *J. B. Raser Jr.*, the said.in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better  
securing the payment thereof to the said *J. B. Raser Jr.* *3/4*according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum  
of Three Dollars, to *W. J. Raser* the said *J. B. Raser*in hand well and truly paid by the said *J. B. Raser Jr.*at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

*J. B. Raser Jr. his heirs and assigns forever,*  
*I, All that certain lot or parcels of land situate in the County*  
*of Greenville State of South Carolina, on north side of East Washington*  
*Street, and containing 5037.5 square feet, more or less, and having the lot*  
*bearing corners and dimensions, beginning at corner, corner of old*  
*warehouse of Lippard & Russell Co., thence along Washington Street*  
*3 1/2 feet eastward 30 feet to corner, thence N. 22 E. one hundred*  
*and fifteen feet (125 ft.); thence N. 71 1/2 E. forty and 3/10*  
*feet to corner, thence S. 22 W. one hundred and twenty*  
*five (125 ft.) feet to corner, and being the same*  
*property described to me by J. C. McDonald, by affidavit dated*  
*May 20, 1913 and recorded in the Office for Greenville County in*  
*Book 18 page 32.*

*Also: All that other piece, lands and lots, and building and*  
*belonging situate on North Washington Street, in the City of Greenville, begin-*  
*ning at a point on North Washington Street 99 feet northerly from E. Washington*  
*Street, a main alley, and running thence along said street 64 feet, more or*  
*less, to the rear end of the property above described; the rest along the*  
*property above described in a northerly direction 36 feet to the line*  
*of property of H. N. Watson et al, known as the old blacksmith*  
*shop, which is now owned by Oscar Wilson Co., thence along line of that prop-*  
*erty in a westerly direction 66 feet, more or less, back to Louis Street,*  
*the rest along Spring Street in a southerly direction 36 feet to a 12 foot alley,*  
*and being the rear portion of property originally known as Russell Co. property.*

*It is understood and agreed that this obligation is to run concur-*

*is a mortgage of \$1000.00 given to William T. Miller.*
