Symmes*All that certain lot or parcel of land situated in Greenville and being in the City of Greenville, S.C. at the Northeast corner of Jones and Wall Avenue and being known as lot No. 21 of a subdivision of property of Parish, C. C. Martin and having, according to a survey made on *March 20, 1928*, the following lines and boundaries, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron gin on the northeast corner of Jones and Jones Avenue and running thence with the northern side of Jones Avenue, S. 88-58 E. 175 feet to an iron gin in line of Lot No. 22; thence with the line of that lot N. 0-48 E. 60 feet to an iron gin in line of Lot No. 20; thence with the line of that lot, N. 88-58 E. 175 feet to an iron gin in line of Jones Avenue; thence with the eastern side of each line of Jones Avenue, S. 0-48 E. 60 feet to the point of beginning.
