All that certain parcel and lot of land, situate,
lying and being in the County and State aforesaid,
in Chick Springs Township, in the City of Greenville, on
the East side of Cunningham Avenue, (now called
Church Street) and designated as lots nos. 19 and 20
on a Plat prepared by W. A. Christopher, recorded in
Plat Book 1, page 17, in R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County, reference to which is hereby made and having
the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on East side of
Cunningham Avenue (Church Street), at the joint
corner of lots nos. 20 and 21, and runs thence S.
21° 20'. One hundred, twenty-five (125) feet to an iron
pin; thence S 70° 20'. One hundred thirty (130) feet to an iron
pin on corner of lot no. 18; thence with the line of lot
no. 18 N 21° E. one hundred, twenty-five (125) feet to an
iron pin on the East side of Cunningham Avenue
(Church Street); thence N 70° E 130 feet to the point and
place of the beginning, and being the same lots of
