WHEREAS, I, the said Vista Murray, of Dr. R. D. Smith, in and by a certain sum of \$500.00, in writing, of even date with these presents, I, Dr. R. D. Smith, am well and truly indebted to Dr. R. D. Smith, in the full and just sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, to be paid Ten Dollars (\$10.00) on the 26th day of Nov. 1933 and Ten Dollars on the 26th day of each month thereafter until paid in full, these payments to be applied on the principal sum, with interest thereon payable semi-annually until paid in full, with interest thereon payable semi-annually until paid in full, date hereof at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually,

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

a reasonable attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

Dr. R. D. Smith, his heirs and assigns the following described real estate: "All of that certain piece, or parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a point on O'Neal Street 100 feet from the corner of O'Neal Street and Y.M.C.A. Streets and running thence in a line parallel with Y.M.C.A. Street in a northerly direction 100 feet; thence with a line parallel with O'Neal Street in a northerly direction of 50 feet; thence in a line parallel with Y.M.C.A. Street and in a southerly direction to O'Neal Street; thence with O'Neal Street in an easterly direction to O'Neal Street, thence with O'Neal Street in an easterly direction 50 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to Isaac Murray by J. Alexander McDowell by deed dated November 12, 1930, and recorded in the R.M.L. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in deed book 157 at page 162. Said tract of land having been this day conveyed by Guy A. Mulliken as Probate Judge for Greenville County.
