In Ward Six of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on South side of Jenkins Street, Corner of Lot No. 4 plat of H. H. Townes property and running thence with east line of Lot No. 4, S. 133-7 N. 129 feet to joint corner of Lot No. 4 and lot now or formerly owned by John Graham and on right-of-way of Southern Railway Company; thence with right-of-way of said Railroad (formerly C. & G.
