J. Riddle, Surveyor, Sept. 20, 1933, and bounded on the North by lands of Herbert Briddle and T. M. Verdin, on the East by lands of the Estate of J. A. Fowler, on the South by J. M. Verdin and the Pliney School property, on the West by C. F.
