I, *blara Sneed*

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said *blara Sneed*  
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

*Frank H. Earle*  
in the full and just sum of *One Hundred Ten (\$10.00)*  
Dollars, to be paid *one year after date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *seven* per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid *annually in advance*

until paid in full; interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of  
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
reue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *twenty five*

*\$25.00* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will  
more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said *blara Sneed*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said,

*Frank H. Earle* according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

*blara Sneed*  
in hand well and truly paid by the said *Frank H. Earle*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell  
and release unto the said *Frank H. Earle, his heirs and assigns*

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of  
land situate, lying and being on the north  
side of East North Street, having the following  
meter and bounds, to wit:

Beginning on John Moore's corner on  
North Street, thence with North Street S. 72 1/4 N.  
50 feet to the corner of Ligon's lot, (formerly John  
Rector's); thence N. 25 N. with Ligon's lot 100 feet,  
thence N. 72 1/4 E. 43 feet and 9 inches to John  
Moore's line; thence with John Moore's line S.  
28 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, being the  
same lot conveyed to me, said blara Sneed,  
by Home Building and Loan Association by
