KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That R. R. Jones (widower), of the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina,

and hereinafter known and designated as Mortgagor, whether one or more, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the mortgagor stands indebted unto HOME OWNERS' LOAN CORPORATION, a Corporation created under Section 4 of an Act of Congress of the United States of America, known as Home Owners' Loan Act of 1933, approved June 13, 1933, with its principal place of business in the City of Washington, in the District of Columbia, in the United States of America, hereinafter known and designated mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, for the full and just principal sum of

Two Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-nine and 59/100

Dollars (\$ 2,669.58 ), payable to the order of the mortgagee, together with interest thereon from the date at the rate of five per centum (5%) per annum on the balance

remaining from time to time unpaid; both principal and interest being payable on an amortization plan in monthly installments of Twenty one and 11/100 Dollars 21.11

(\$ 21.11) per month on the first day of each and every month hereafter; the payments being applied, first, to interest on unpaid balances, and the remainder to principal until said debt is paid in full. Extra payments may be made on the due date of any installment, and interest will be charged only on the balance of said debt remaining unpaid.

IT BEING AGREED by the terms of said note that the borrower, or undersigned, may pay the sum of Eleven and 12/100 Dollars

(\$ 11.12) monthly from date to and including June, 1936, representing interest only on said debt, at his option, provided all other conditions and covenants of the note, and the

instruments securing the same, are promptly met, and thereafter, the monthly payment shall be Twenty-four and 69/100 (\$24.69) Dollars (\$ 24.69) per month, to be applied, first, to interest on the balance remaining unpaid, and the remainder to principal, until said debt is paid in full, all of which, and such other terms and conditions as contained in said note, will fully appear by reference thereto; default in payment of any installment of principal and/or interest for a period of ninety (90) days to render the whole debt due at the option of the mortgagee.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and the sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said mortgagee, according to the terms of the said note and of this mortgage, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release, in fee simple, unto the mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described land, to wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, or to be erected thereon, situate, lying and being

on the western side of McGee Street, in the Ward Two of the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, known as #11 McGee Street, and being bounded as follows: On the North by three lots now or formerly owned by L. L. Holland, Perry Woods and W. E. Rush; on the East by McGee Street; on the South by lot now or formerly owned by W.B. Sutherland; and on the West by a ten-foot alley; being shown and delineated as Lot #45 and a portion of Lot #46 on plat of property known as The Rowley Place, (the name of the engineer, the date and for whom made not appearing), recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C", at Page 5; and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the Western side of McGee Street, about 50 feet 10 inches (50' 10") North of a ten-foot alley, and running thence S. 80 W. 155 feet to an alley; thence N. 21-45 W. 50 feet 10 inches (50' 10") to a stake on said alley; thence N. 80 E. 103 feet 4 inches (103' 4") to corner of lot now or formerly owned by W. E. Rush; thence along rear line of that lot fifty-one feet three inches (51' 3"), more or less, to McGee Street; thence along McGee Street S. 21-45 E. 60 feet 7 inches to the point of commencement; said premises being that conveyed to R. R. Jones by John L. Hacker by deed dated June 27, 1928, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds "136" at Page 121.
