AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

John R. Rodgers and Sunie Rodgers (also known as John R. Rodgers and Sunie E. Rodgers)

County and State aforesaid, hereinafter called first party, whether one or more,

WHEREAS, first party is indebted to The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, a corporation created, organized and existing under and by virtue of an Act of Congress, entitled the Federal Farm Loan Act, hereinafter called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of Two Thousand & no/oo *Two Thousand & no/oo* Dollars,

payable to the order of the second party, together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid, at the rate of Five (5%) per centum per annum (or at the rate of interest fixed by Act of Congress),

the first payment on interest being due and payable on the First day of December, 1934, and thereafter interest being due and payable in

Twenty (20) equal, successive, annual installments of One Hundred & no/oo *One Hundred & no/oo* Dollars,

each and a final installment of One Hundred & no/oo *One Hundred & no/oo* Dollars, the first installment of said principal being due and payable on the First day of December, 1935,

and thereafter the remaining installments of principal being due and payable annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full, and each installment of principal and interest bearing interest from the date until paid at the highest rate authorized to be charged under the Federal Farm Loan Act as amended; all of which and such other terms, conditions and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.



The debt secured by the said note has been satisfied in full by the First payment of \$2,000.00 on December 1, 1934, and all subsequent payments have been made in full.

All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land lying and being situate in Rutledge Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the old Spartanburg Road about four and one half (4 1/2) miles from the City limits of Greenville, containing sixty-seven and one hundredths (67.17) acres, according to a plat made by J. W. Freeman, Surveyor, November 2, 1933, and bounded on the north by Ben Howard's land, and the P. B. Green Estate, on the East by Mrs. D. L. Hudson's Estate, on the south by lots of E. P. Hudson and on the west by the Spencer land, and described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the old Rutledge Hill road on land of Spencer and running thence North 37 degrees 30 minutes East 6 chains 41 links to a stone, thence North 13 degrees 15 minutes East 15 chains 66 links to a stone, thence South 88 degrees 30 minutes East 3 chains 52 links to a stone, thence South 52 degrees East 11 chains 72 links to a point in road, thence South 23 degrees 30 minutes East 12 chains 50 links to a double poplar, on branch, thence North 49 5/8 degrees East 3 chains 46 links to a poplar, thence south 42 degrees East 20 chains 50 links to an iron pin, thence south 84 3/8 degrees East 1 chain 8 links to an iron pin, thence south 23 degrees 45 minutes West 10 chains 63 links to a stone, thence North 69 1/2 degrees West 20 chains 80 links to a stone, thence North 37 degrees West 2 chains 70 links to a stone, thence North 37 degrees 15 minutes West 16 chains 86 links to the beginning corner.

Said tract of land is made up of two conveyances, one from J. W. Kirby, master to John R. Rodgers which is recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in book K.R.T. at page 174, and the other from L. L. Green and Eula Green Taylor to Sunie Rodgers by a deed recorded in book 24, page 440 in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County and a portion of the said land is owned by John R. Rodgers and another portion by Sunie E. Rodgers, but the plat includes both tracts surveyed together.
